Ohio House Bill HB16 College Tuition

On November 6th a Higher Education committee held its 5th hearing on bill to grant residency status for in-state college tuition to active military service members and their spouses and their dependents.

Ohio House Bill HB133 Occupational Licenses

On October 2nd the house bill to require state occupational licensing agencies, under certain circumstances, to issue temporary licenses or certificates to members of the military and spouses who are licensed in another jurisdiction and have moved to Ohio for active duty had their 1st hearing in the Senate by the Transportation, Commerce & Workforce.

Ohio House Bill HB287 Military Waiver Services

On October 29th the house bill had its 4th hearing with the Ohio Provider Resource Association regarding Medicaid home and community-based waiver services for relatives of active duty military.

Appropriations:

Congress did not complete action on appropriations before the end of the fiscal year on Sept. 30. The House passed a continuing resolution (CR) on Sept. 19 that funds the government through Nov. 21, which the Senate passed on Sept. 26 and President Trump signed on Sept. 27. The House and Senate, meanwhile, are expected to use the next few weeks to continue negotiations on full appropriations for the rest of FY 2020.

Explanation of terms used for Ohio Senate and House Bills:

Continued – Bill remains in its assigned committee to await further hearings, amendments, etc.

Reported – The committee has voted the bill out of committee and recommends its passage on the House or Senate floor

Referred – A newly introduced bill is assigned to a committee

Introduced – A new bill that has recently been assigned a number

Scheduled but not heard – A bill that was supposed to have a hearing in committee, but was passed over due to sponsor/chair request

Cancelled - Awaiting a new hearing date

Enacted - A bill that has passed both House and Senate and has been signed by the Governor
